This year the 4 membership award categories are:

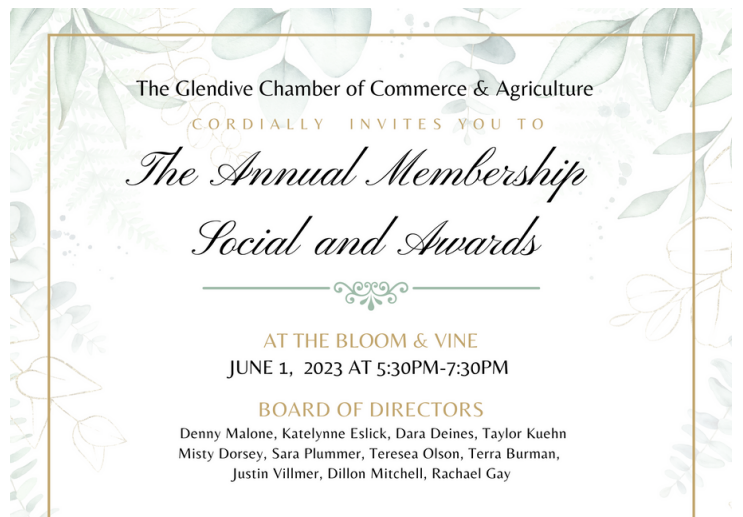

Frontier Gateway Museum

Frontier Gateway Museum features historical displays ranging from prehistoric fossils found locally to a wide array of displays representing Native Americans, steamships on the Yellowstone, early ranchers and homesteaders, the Northern Pacific Railway, clothing through the years, several early businesses, medical issues, and a host of other events and issues from the Dawson County area. In addition to four large display areas in the main building, the extensive grounds feature a country schoolhouse, firehall with two amazing vintage firetrucks, two country stores, a blacksmith shop, and a buggy barn. Visitors can also see a restored windmill and a Northern Pacific caboose. The museum also has extensive archives, and the attendants will be happy to assist with research for families or authors. Visitors and locals will also want to listen to the 20 Talking Trail points which highlight a variety of local people and places. The museum is located at 201 State Street (the Belle Prairie Frontage Road). The museum will open for the summer season on May 20th and will be open 1:00-5:00 until May 30th; when it will switch to summer hours which are Monday-Saturday 9 am to 5 pm and Sunday 1-5 pm. If those hours do not work, the museum is available by appointment by calling 406-377-3018 or 406-365-4653.

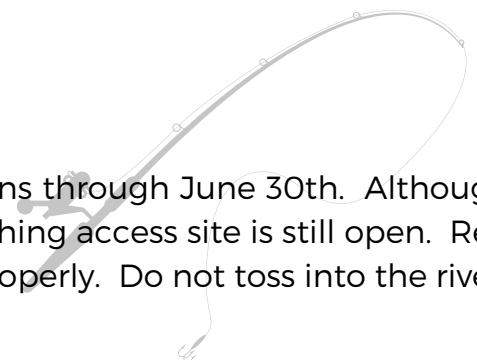

PADDFISHING SEASON

May 15th, 2023 - June 30th, 2023

Paddlefishing Season Opens May 15th 2023 and runs through June 30th. Although there will be no fish cleaning provided this year the Intake fishing access site is still open. Remember to clean your fish responsibly and dispose of scraps properly. Do not toss into the river.



Fishing Regulation Reminders

It is unlawful to snag any other species of fish other than paddlefish. If a species of fish other than paddlefish is snagged it must be immediately released alive.

Intake fishing access site harvest days are Tuesdays, Wednesday, Fridays, & Saturday. Catch and release days are Sunday, Monday, & Thursdays. Down stream of the Intake Fishing access site harvest days are Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays, & Saturdays. No catch and release days downstream of Intake.
