Save Time and Sign Up with Locl

How to sign up for Locl (getting started takes as little as 5 minutes!)

1. Create your Locl account

- Once your Google Business Profile(s) have been claimed and verified, head over to <https://locl.io/glendive/> to create your free Locl account.
 - Note: if you have more than one location, you will not need to create a separate Locl account!

2. Connect your GBP Account to Locl.

- You will be prompted to login (if you are not already) to GBP and "allow" Locl access. This connects your GBP account to Locl, enabling you to make updates to your GBP profile, using Locl.

3. Complete your account setup

- There are a few additional fields you will need to fill out in order to complete the process. Please note: you may change these inputs any time once you are in Locl.

4. You're in! Get familiar with Locl!
