### Foster Care Project

The Foster Care Project is a volunteer organization dedicated to providing assistance and support to foster children and foster families across Eastern Montana.



Fundraising efforts go to benefit the needs of foster families and children. Some of the special activities for foster children that they fund are graduation pictures, formal attire for Proms, sports fees and uniforms, and camp fees. Each child in the foster care program receives a duffel from us with his or her name embroidered on the key tag; and filled with age appropriate items. The Project puts on foster family fun days to show support and build community within the foster families. Another service they provide is the clothes closet, which is a collection of new and like new clothing available for foster children to have to offset the cost of necessary clothing for their foster family.
